

**The Siegelbaum Literary and Visual Arts Competition  
Contest Guidelines 2017- 2018**

**Please use the checklist to ensure your entry meets all of the guidelines and requirements.**

- 1. My entry relates to the contest theme: ***Resilience***.
- 2. My entry is accompanied by a completed Siegelbaum Literary & Visual Arts Competition Entry Form. (If the entry was created by a group, there must be a completed entry form for each and every student who participated in it.
- 3. My name or school name does **NOT** appear on the entry itself.
- 4. My entry falls into one of the following categories: prose, poetry, or visual arts.
- 5. My entry is original and unpublished. (No revisions will be accepted once an entry is received.)
- 6. My prose entries must be in 12 point type, double spaced, and must be limited to 500 words.
- 7. My poetry entries must be in 12 point type and double spaced.
- 8. My artwork is NOT matted or framed and the brief explanation is typed.  
\*If my artwork is 3-D it can be placed on a stand without support or support must be provided.
- 9. My submission is NOT a video presentation. (We are unable to accept video presentations.)
- 10. My entry has been submitted to the Museum no later than **May 4, 2018, at 5:00 p.m.**
- 11. **I understand that if my submission neglects to meet the guidelines or theme of this Competition it will be disqualified.**

**General Information**

- 1. By entering the Siegelbaum Literary and Visual Arts Competition, permission is hereby granted by participants and their parents/guardians to give the Holocaust Museum & Center for Tolerance and Education to use their names and submissions in print or internet form.
- 2. Entries will be judged by middle school and high school divisions in three categories: prose, poetry, and visual arts. Awards will be given to awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each category.
- 3. Winners will be notified via email during the last week of **May 2018**.
- 4. Winners will be recognized at an award ceremony to be held on **June 15, 2018**. All winners are encouraged to attend.
- 5. All entries may be picked up beginning June 18, 2018. Entries which have not been claimed by July 20, 2018 become the property of the Museum.
