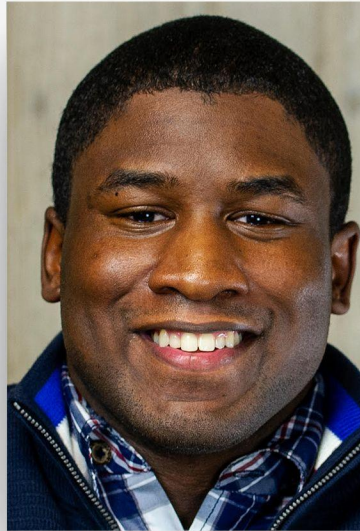


# FACES OF RCC EXHIBIT
