All entries must fall into one of the following categories:

LITERARY ARTS: Prose, Poetry, or Essays up to 1,000 words

VISUAL ARTS: Must be submitted by email in PDF or JPEG format

MULTIMEDIA: Videos no longer than 4 minutes in length

For students grades 6-12

Submissions must be original and unpublished and received electronically by the Museum no later than March 1, 2022.

First, Second and Third place winners will be awarded in two separate divisions: middle school and high school, and in three separate categories: Literary Arts, Multimedia and Visual Arts. The submitting teacher of each first place prize winning student will receive a \$100 gift card to spend for their classroom (one per teacher). Work will be judged by a prominent group of educators.

Winners will be announced on May 16, 2022 and will be recognized at an Awards Ceremony on June 7, 2022.
